GENERAL INFORMATION:

Do you want to be a part of an award-winning team who delivers world-class maintenance to keep Portland Airport (PDX) in tip-top shape? The PDX Maintenance Helpers support multiple journeyman trade workgroups. We are looking for candidates with a positive attitude and a willingness to learn, who share our passion for delivering excellence. This position will initially support the Port's Landscape Maintenance crew, however, could be re-assigned to another craft based on operational need at any time.

NOTE: This is a union represented position; shifts are bid based on seniority. The successful candidate must be available to work any shift and be assigned to any workgroup.

SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Landscape Maintenance:
 - Mow grass, edge, and remove clippings using power equipment.
 - Assist with planting trees, shrubs, and ground cover.
 - Operate and perform minor maintenance and repairs to specialized tools and power equipment.
 - Assist with pruning and irrigation work.
- General Maintenance:
 - Perform routine labor functions.
 - Operate small tools and equipment.
 - Assist with maintenance and repair of pavements, fences, drainage systems, etc.
- Vehicle Maintenance:
 - Perform lube, oil, and filter preventative maintenance.
 - Change tires and batteries.
 - Perform safety and operational checks on vehicles and equipment.
 - Assist with diagnosis and repairs on vehicles and equipment.
- HVAC Maintenance:
 - Perform routine HVAC equipment inspection for preventative maintenance and filter changes.
 - Assist HVAC personnel with equipment repairs and services.
 - Perform routine labor tasks as required at the CUP, and terminal mechanical rooms.
- Building Maintenance:
 - Perform lube and oil preventative maintenance services on bag belt and loading bridge equipment.
 - Assist the building mechanic personnel with building repairs and services;
 - Perform preparatory work, and assist with painting and sanding of buildings and equipment.
 - Perform routine labor tasks as required, such as escorts and moving terminal furniture.

- Storeroom Operations:
 - Assist storeroom personnel with material handling and shipping.
 - Perform parts runs, filling pick tickets, routine cycle counts.
 - Perform routine labor tasks as required, such as escorts and housekeeping.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

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- High school diploma or GED is required.
- Course work and/or relevant experience in landscape maintenance, general construction, vehicle maintenance, HVAC, building maintenance, and/or Warehousing is preferred.
- Valid driver's license at time of hire is required.
- Class B Commercial driver's license at time of hire is preferred, or the ability to obtain within the probationary period is required.
- Must be able to pass a criminal history records check to obtain security clearance for unescorted access to the Port facilities.

SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Effective verbal and written communications skills.
- Able to lift 50 pounds, stand or walk for long periods of time, and work in adverse weather conditions including heat, wind, and rain.
- Demonstrated ability to work cooperatively and interact effectively with diverse workgroups.
- Ability to perform multiple tasks with limited supervision.
- Demonstrated knowledge of trade areas utilizing materials, tools, and skills required to accomplish maintenance tasks.
