The successful candidate will work closely with our Public Safety professionals; including the Port of Portland Police Department, Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Department, and our own Communications Center (911 Dispatch) to ensure these critical systems are well maintained and accessible. If you possess a sense of team-oriented camaraderie, like to have fun, and take pride in your work this might be the job for you!

- Provide day-to-day support of Public Safety systems.
- Perform systems implementation and upgrading of commercial technology solutions, working with vendors as needed.
- Schedule for system upgrades including version testing, interface impact analysis, and testing.
- Develop documentation of acquired systems and their impacts to existing systems and process, as well as deployment of associated systems interfaces.
- Collaborate with colleagues to ensure successful delivery of reliable services through the coordination of staff and technology resources.
- Provide an IT perspective to projects, addressing any of the above responsibilities as they
 pertain to each specific project.
- Participate when needed for facilities construction projects from design review, to system testing and implementation, through commissioning then followed by ongoing operational support.

- Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Information Systems or a related field is preferred, or the equivalent combination of education and/or relevant experience is required.
- Minimum of five (5) years relevant work experience in information technology. NOTE:
 Candidates with fewer years of experience may be considered for a lower-level position.
- Knowledge of Public Safety systems such as Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), MDC/MDT, FIS, USDD Tapout, etc.
- Experience with the integration of information systems and reporting systems, including handling of information with appropriate levels of security and confidentiality.
- Experience with application support and administration activities for purchased or developed products.
- Knowledge of networks and data transmission as it applies to operational systems and operations.
- Working knowledge of CAD and Engineering drawing development and review through Bluebeam.
- Experience with technology systems and their related computerized applications.
- Knowledge of SQL (desirable).
- Ability to obtain and maintain security clearance for unescorted access to secure areas of the Port's airports, marine terminals and other properties is required.
- Must be physically able to climb stairs, ladders, and inclines; and lift and carry up to 50 pounds unassisted.

 - Work collaboratively with a broad-based team involving airport IT, systems maintenance and operations groups.
 - Occasionally respond quickly to 24/7 production systems issues and concerns during and after business hours.
 - Resolve problems with minimal conflict, and motivate colleagues to collaborate.
 - Multi-task in a high energy environment; proactively work through ambiguity.
 - Work without supervision and apply good judgment on when to escalate matters.
