

Heavy Vehicle Mechanic

We are looking for a motivated person to fulfill the position of Heavy Vehicle Mechanic for our location at Portland International Airport. The main responsibilities are to ensure that the fleet of de-icing trucks and service vehicles is properly maintained and in good working order.

Main Responsibilities:

- Perform repairs on de-icing trucks and service vehicles;
- Regular maintenance of de-icing trucks and service vehicles;
- Perform a prescribed preventative maintenance program on the fleet and service vehicles and automobiles;
- Initiate repair cost estimates;
- Perform general overhaul, installation, repair, replacement and adjustment of bearings, ignitions, carburetors, transmissions, differentials, axles, steering mechanisms, drive shafts, fenders, radiators and front end and rear suspension systems;
- Ensure that vehicles are clean and in good working order;
- Immediately report any anomalies or questions to his/her supervisor;
- Complete all necessary documents and reports as required;
- Inspect, diagnose, overhaul, adjust and repair gas and diesel powered trucks, automobiles and other power equipment
- Perform work in adherence to safe work practices and procedures and in compliance with applicable standards and specifications, including to perform work in accordance with and maintain equipment as required;
- Maintain a variety of records, including vehicle identification, date, mileage and nature of each inspection, maintenance, lubrication and repair performed;
- Maintain and document all purchase orders;
- Perform related duties and responsibilities as required.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS:

- Ability to meet physical requirements necessary to safely and effectively perform required duties;
- Operate tools necessary for mechanic work;
- Possession of a valid and appropriate State Driver's License;
- Possession of a safe driving record that is in compliance with the restrictions set forth by the State;
- Be self-directed and work independently.

Essential Skills:

- Must have at least three (3) to six (6) years experience in repairing heavy duty diesel trucks;
- Journeyman Heavy Equipment Technical, Automotive or Agricultural;
- Ability to diagnose and troubleshoot electrical, electronics and hydraulic systems;



- Experience with Freightliner, Mercedes and/or Volvo type of equipment would be an asset;
- Read and write at a sufficient level to successfully perform the required duties;

- Knowledge and experience in electricity, electronics and hydraulics would be an important asset
