- Delegate lunches and breaks periods
- Review schedules and change employees roles to meet the needs of the business
- Use POS system to ring tickets
- Responsible for cash register
- Work cash register for the grab and go section
- Work the sandwich line, take orders from over the counter and run food to tables
- Understand house abbreviations, hot food menu, salad selection, as well as grab and go items
- Stocking paper goods, food items, sandwich line, espresso counter, etc...
- Other duties as assigned
